**Announcement by the Council for Democratic Reform No. 29:
Amendment of Announcement by the Council for Democratic Reform No. 12
dated 20 September B.E. 2549 (2006)**

Pursuant to Announcement by the Council for Democratic Reform No. 12 dated 20 September B.E. 2549 (2006), stipulating that the Organic Law on State Audit B.E. 2542 (1999) continues to be in force, so as to provide clarity regarding the applicability of this Organic Law, the Council for Democratic Reform declares as follows:

1. The provisions in Article 1 of Announcement by the Council for Democratic Reform No. 12 dated 20 September B.E. 2549 (2006) are repealed and replaced by the following:

“1. The abrogation of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand shall not prejudice the Organic Law on State Audit B.E. 2542 (1999), which shall continue to remain in force, except for provisions in Part 1, Chapter 1, until it is further amended by law or is annulled. Furthermore, members of the State Audit Commission as of 18 September B.E. 2549 (2006) shall relinquish their position.”

2. The provisions in Article 2 of Announcement by the Council for Democratic Reform No. 12 dated 20 September B.E. 2549 (2006) shall be repealed and replaced by the following:

“2. The Auditor-General as of 18 September B.E. 2549 (2006) shall remain in office until 30 September B.E. 2550 (2007).”

3. New members of the State Audit Commission and the new Auditor-General shall be selected and appointed, in accordance with the Organic Law on State Audit B.E. 2542 (1999), within 90 days after the current Auditor-General relinquishes her position, as stipulated by the provisions in Article 2 of Announcement by the Council for Democratic Reform No. 12 dated 20 September B.E. 2549 (2006), as further amended by this Announcement.

During the absence of members of the State Audit Commission and the Auditor-General in accordance with the first paragraph, the Auditor-General who has just relinquished her position pursuant to the first paragraph shall provisionally continue to perform the duties of the State Audit Commission and the Auditor-General.
