**Announcement by the Council for Democratic Reform No. 6:  
Measures to Remedy the Hardship of Workers and Farmers**

Given the hardship of workers and farmers in relation to their condition of living, the Council for Democratic Reform acknowledges such hardship with great sympathy and is considering measures to help alleviate their hardship. However, the Council is presently addressing problems affecting the nation's peace and order so as to restore normalcy. Workers and farmers are therefore requested to remain calm and not to engage in any activities seeking remedial action at the moment as such activities could be exploited by those with ill-intentions to instigate disturbances in the Kingdom. As for the hardship of workers and farmers, the Council will expeditiously consider appropriate measures to undertake so as to alleviate their hardship in due course.
